

- GMPLS is out! (January)
- IDN is out! (March)
- IP Storage is out!
- Diameter (AAA) is out!
- SMTP Delivery Notifications at Draft!
- SNMPv3 is at Full Standard!

- Appeal on IPv6 addressing architecture
  - Rejected by the IESG, accepted by the IAB
- Appeal on Internet FAX to Draft
  - Based on a misunderstanding, withdrawn
- Appeal on a RADIUS extension to Info
  - Accepted by the IESG
