
What is this data?

- Want to be careful not to conclude too much from limited data.


I-D Approval

- Metrics from IETF to IETF
 - IETF meetings are a nice marker
- Queue Additions:
 - Requested: WG or RFC-Editor asks for publication
- Queue Removals:
 - Approved: IESG approves
 - Returned to AD is Watching: usually the document got sent back to the WG (more than just “revised I-D needed”)
 - Dead: The IETF doesn’t want/need to track this document any more


Approved Returned to AD Is Watching Dead
