Comments on the Unicode Codepoints and IDNA Internet-Draft (draft-ietf-idnabis-tables-02.txt)

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Introduction

NIDA (National Internet Development Agency of Korea) appreciates this Internet-draft document on the Unicode Codepoints and IDNA.

We have carefully reviewed the Unicode Codepoints and IDNA Internet-Draft with professionals from Korean Agency for Technology and Standards (National Body of ISO and IEC), the National Institute of The Korean Language, etc.

Comments on the Hangul codepoints.

We have classified the Hangul Unicode codepoints like the followings.

1. Hangul Jamo (U+1100 - U+11FF)

These characters in Hangul Jamo block are used for composing Hangul syllable blocks. They cannot be used alone. Since modern Hangul syllables must be represented by using the code positions in Hangul syllable block (U+AC00 – U+D7A3), this Hangul Jamo block is not needed for Korean IDN.

In addition, we do not allow Old Hangul letters for Korean IDN.

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2. Bangjeom (U+302E, U+302F)

A Bangjeom is a notation in Hunminjeongeum for representing tones for Hangul syllable blocks. It is a combining mark and therefore they cannot be used alone. It must be appended to a Hangul syllable block. Therefore, it is not needed for Korean IDN.

Recommendation:

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<u>302E ; DISALLOWED # HANGUL SINGLE DOT TONE MARK = single dot Bangjeom</u>
<u>302F ; DISALLOWED # HANGUL DOUBLE DOT TONE MARK = double dot Bangjeom</u>
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3. Hangul Compatibility Jamo (U+3131 - U+318E)

Hangul Compatibility Jamo in this block is used alone to represent fullwidth Hangul consonant and vowel letters individually. There is a risk using these characters for IDN because the combination of them might be visually confusable to Internet users. For instance, ' \neg \models .kr' (U+3131 U+314F) IDN can be confused with the '7 \models .kr' (U+AC00) IDN.

Furthermore, when we apply a current normalization, ' \neg \vdash ' (U+3131 U+314F) is actually transformed to ' \neg \vdash ' (U+AC00). As a result, these two Korean IDNs become one and the same.

Recommendation: DISALLOWED

4. Hangul codepoints in Enclosed CJK Letters and Months character code table Internet Draft:

3200..321E ; DISALLOWED # PARENTHESIZED HANGUL KIYEOK..PARENTHESIZED K 3250..32FE ; DISALLOWED # PARTNERSHIP SIGN..CIRCLED KATAKANA WO

We do no allow parenthesized and circled Hangul characters for Korean IDN.

Recommendation: DISALLOWED

5. Hangul Syllables (U+AC00 - U+D7A3)

This block is used for representing 11,172 modern Hangul syllables.

Recommendation: PVALID

6. Halfwidth Hangul variants (U+FFA0 - U+FFDC)

We do no allow Halfwidth Hangul variants for Korean IDN.

Recommendation: DISALLOWED
